In 1899 while serving in the 2nd Boer War, Robert Baden-Powell penned his sixth military book, *Aids To Scouting*. Hines wrote the 8th, and Robert Birkby the 10th, 11th and 12th editions. The first Official Handbook, subtitled A Handbook of Woodcraft, Scouting, and Life-craft was published from July 1910 until March 1911 and appeared in eight distinct variations. It was written by Ernest Seton and drew greatly on Baden-Powell's Scouting for Boys, it included information on the organization of Scouting, signs and signaling, and camping, as well as Scouting games and a description of several Scouting honours. Notably, this book did not place emphasis on first aid, knife and axe use, or map and compass work, as later editions would.
