The Gingerbread Lady

Although Dermot Healy (1947-2014) is probably best known as an award-winning novelist and poet, he was also a prolific playwright, screenwriter, and actor. Healy's interest in drama was long-standing, and was central to his development as a writer. Between 1985 and 2010 he wrote thirteen stage plays, including a critically-acclaimed adaptation of Garcia Lorca's Blood Wedding in 1989. All of these plays are published here for the first time. One of the most striking features of Healy's dramatic works is their spirit of community collaboration and their strong social conscience. His first play, *Here and There and Going to America* (1985), was

performed by members of the Sligo Dole Q Company; *Metagama* (2004) was written for Theatre Hebrides on the Isle of Lewis; *Serious* (2005) was written in collaboration with (and performed by) prisoners from Castlereagh Prison; *A Night at the Disco* (2006) was written in collaboration with the teachers and students of St Mary's Secondary School in Ballina. These community-based productions were interspersed with more professional commissions, including *Mr Staines*, performed by Pan Pan Theatre Company at the Samuel Beckett Theatre in Dublin in 1999, and *Men to the Right, Women to the Left*, first performed at The Abbey Theatre in 2005 by the Clones Drama Group. Although the settings of Healy's plays are often local and regional by design, their reach is always international and universal. With the publication of this volume, Healy's contribution to drama seems certain to flourish amongst practitioners and scholars alike, and *The Collected Plays* will be of great interest to all devotees of contemporary Irish theatre."

God's Favorite

Everyone has heard of St Helena, but nobody knows much about it. This suits most of its inhabitants just fine. Unfortunately it does not suit its remote rulers in London, who think it costs too much and ideally should be made to earn money for them. It is still a mini-colony in the time when these stories are set, complete with a Governor with feathers on his hat. The locals just want to get on with their lives. But money is short and many of them are forced to leave, sometimes forever.

These stories are mostly a light-hearted look at life on this tiny island. They have an airport now, but these are tales of life in earlier times that will soon seem very remote, a peep into a way of life that will soon be forgotten. There are some marvellous local characters with all their problems and peccadilloes, the good and not-so-good officials sent out from London to try and run the place. There is also the unwanted official visitor when it is sensed that the remote control from afar is not as effective as it might be. And the assorted mercenaries, missionaries and misfits who briefly appear in their lives. As in all small places there are endless opportunities to scheme and manoeuvre to achieve their respective ends.
